DESCRIPTION

The Hagler-Cole Cabin is a gabled rectangle with wide overhanging roof. Its narrower facade facing the street is enlivened by a rugged fieldstone fireplace beside the corner entry door, and by a gabled front porch spanning half the front elevations. A spacious deck along the south side of the cottage is uncovered and is reached only from the cottage interior. One corner of the deck is occupied by a stairway leading to a spacious lower floor, made possible by the steeply sloping site. All openings on the south and west sides at both levels are closed only by screens and canvas blinds. Glazed windows are used on the north and east faces.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C, A Area of significance: Recreation and Architecture

The Hagler-Cole Cabin, unusually spacious with its fully-developed two floors, has been owned and seasonally occupied by three generations of the same family. Its interior demonstrates the modest but inevitable modifications, more obvious on the interior than the exterior, which reflect the fluctuations of family size. This cottage, like so many of its neighbors of the same time period, maximizes its organic blend with the wooded hillside by the use of roughsawn detailing. Only a small percentage of what was originally once five-hundred cabins at Bella Vista remain, and only a handful of these survive virtually unaltered. The Hagler-Cole Cabin is one of these.
