DESCRIPTION

The McIntyre House is a double-pile one-and-one-half story vernacular farmhouse sided with weatherboard. **Wide clipped gables on both side elevations** give a nearly hipped-roof impression. A shed-roof porch supported by turned posts with simple Queen Anne detail wraps around three elevations of the house. A large dormer with two windows pierces the roof of the facade above the point of the two centralized entrances. A window central to each of the two flanking bays completes the fenestration of the facade. All windows are one-over-one double-hung.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: Architecture

The McIntyre House is significant as an excellent example of a rural farmhouse constructed after the turn of the century. **Virtually unaltered**, its wide clipped gables and use of Queen Anne ornamentation make it unique among surviving buildings of its type in the area.
