DESCRIPTION

Two story and irregular in plan, the house at 305 E. Ashley in Siloam Springs is a vernacular adaptation of turn-of-the century architectural styles. A corner single-door entrance bay, with pyramidal roof capped with metal cresting, is flanked on the south and west elevations by two-story bays with shingled gables. The longer southern elevation also has a single-story bay window. Ornamental brackets support eaves on all bays and all corners feature corner boards with capitals. A one-story wrap-around porch is supported by simple classical columns. The house is sheathed in novelty siding; windows are one-over-one double-hung. Small one-story additions to the rear do not detract from the building's integrity.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: CArea of significance: architecture

The property at 305 E. Ashley in Siloam Springs is an example of small-town interpretation of turn-of-the-century architectural styles. The high degree of integrity and use of both Queen Anne and classical ornamentation make it a significant architectural resource in the area.
