Summary

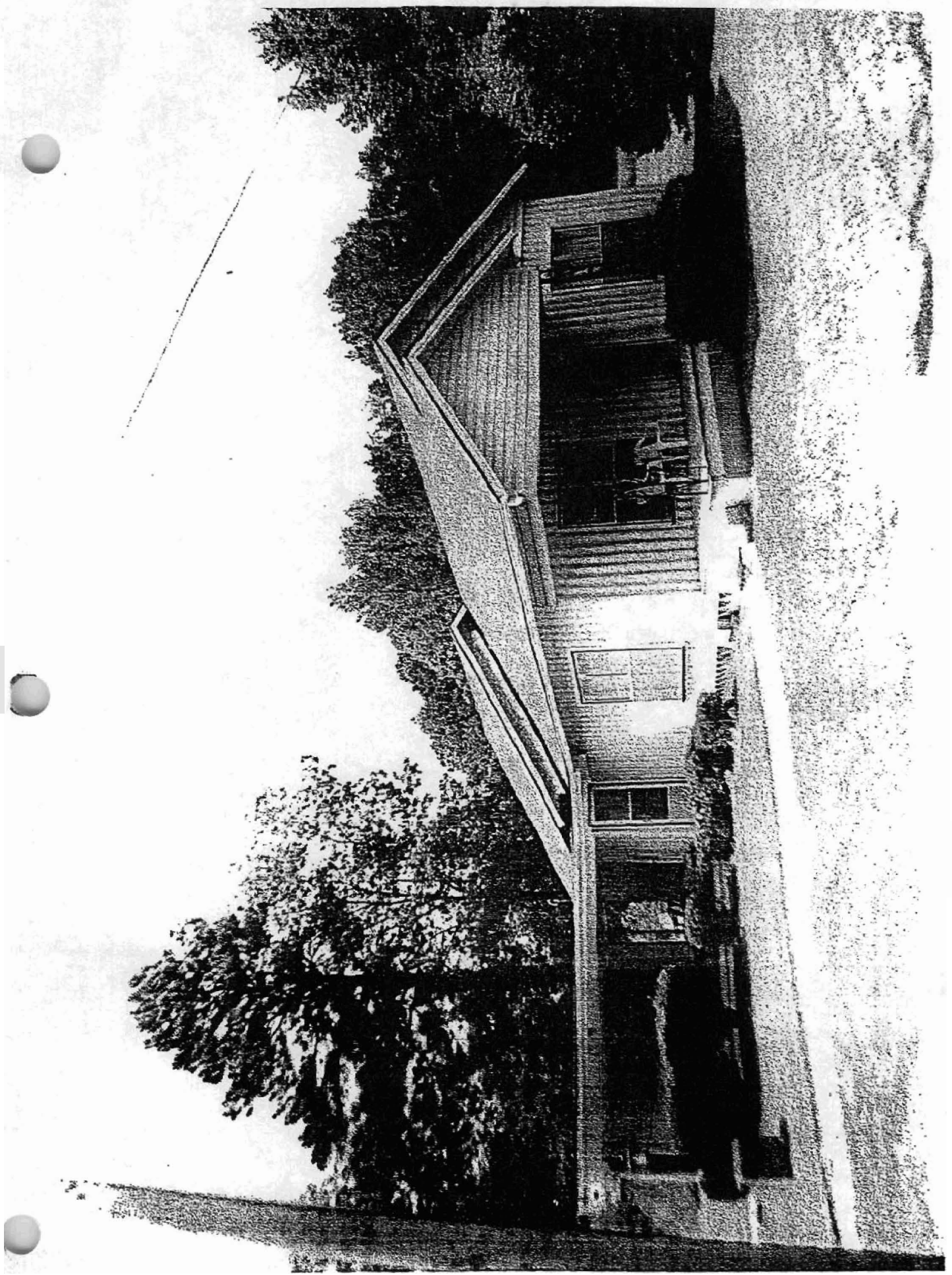
Koon House #1 is a single-story, gable roof residence constructed of relatively small logs placed vertically and split in half so that the round, unfinished side faces the exterior while the smooth, flat side faces the interior. Its floor plan is irregular, and a non-historic carport and storage shed have been added to the southern elevation toward the southwest corner. There are no extant chimneys. The building is supported on cast concrete piers and covered with an asphalt shingle roof.

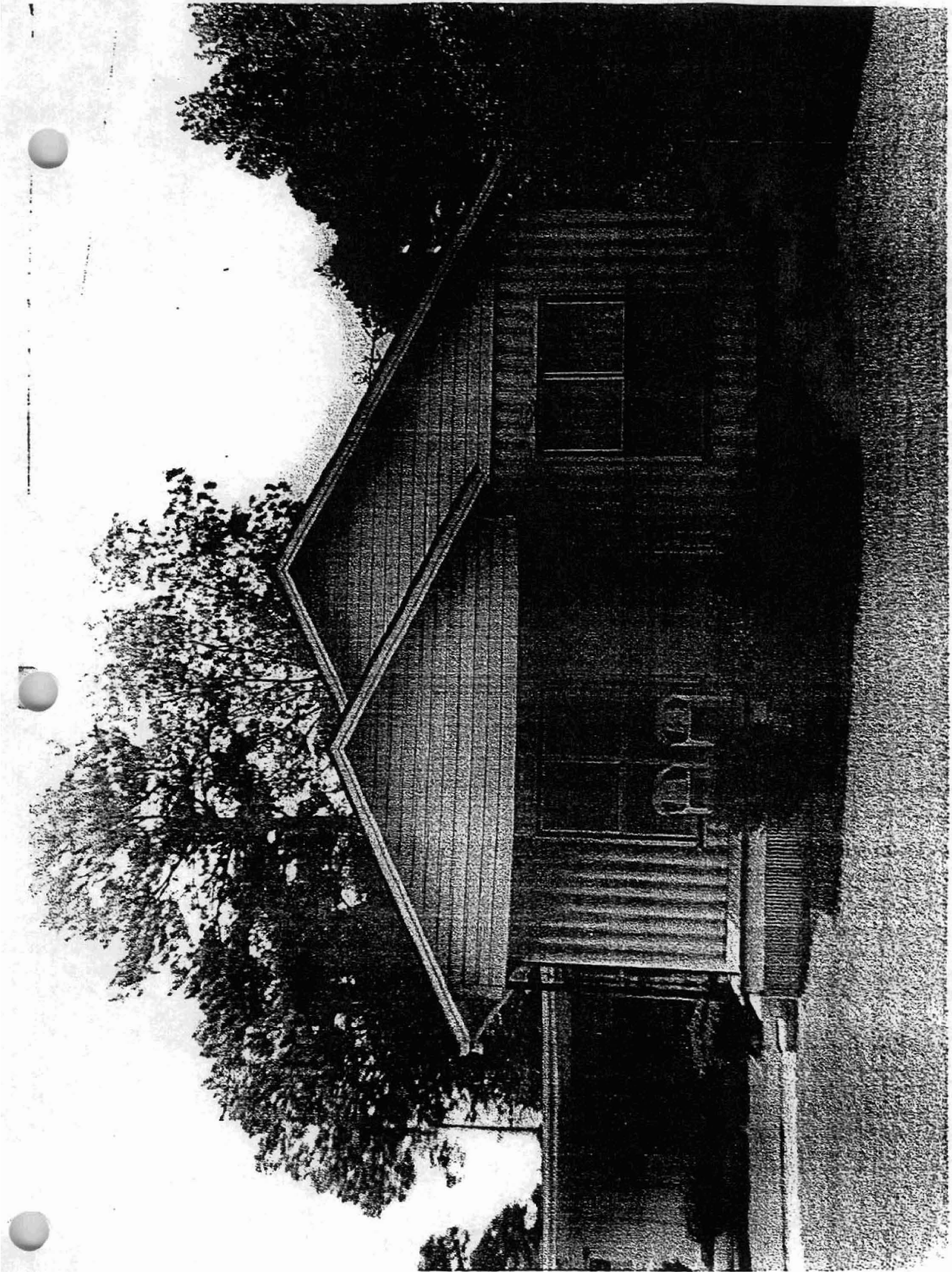
Elaboration

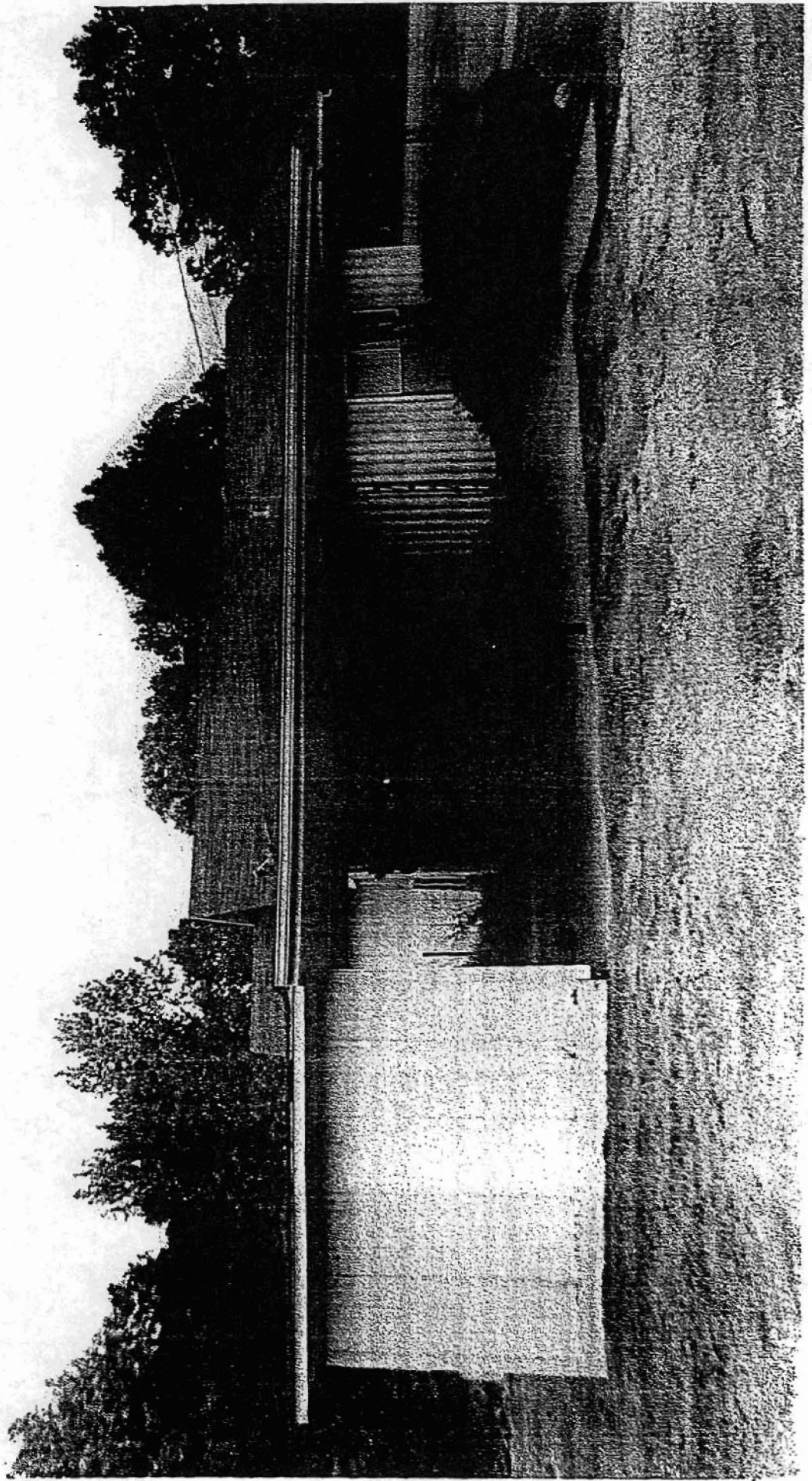
Koon House #1 is a single-story, gable roof residence constructed of relatively small logs placed vertically and split in half so that the round, unfinished side faces the exterior while the smooth, flat side faces the interior. Its floor plan is irregular, with a small gabled porch projecting from the building's eastern or front elevation, and a non-historic carport and storage shed have been added to the southern elevation toward the southwest corner. There are no extant chimneys. The building is supported on cast concrete piers and covered with an asphalt shingle roof.

The eastern or front elevation is dominated by the gable roof porch that is now supported upon wrought iron posts. A pair of large, one-over-one windows is set into the middle of the back wall of the recessed porch and another pair is placed in the center of the wall to the north. A single-leaf door set into the north wall of the recessed porch provides access to the interior. The southern elevation is also lit with two pair of one-over-one windows, and another single-leaf door is placed into the eastern-facing wall where the larger rear gabled section of the house projects out from the wall of the smaller, front gable. The later carport and storage shed extend from this elevation. The western or rear elevation is relatively simple, as it is punctuated only with a single window and adjacent door placed into the end of the small, projecting gable at the rear of the house, and another single window that lights the side wall of the gable projecting toward the carport. The northern elevation features two pair of the large one-over-one windows and another pair of smaller windows toward the rear.

The alterations to Koon House #1 are restricted to the addition of the carport and storage shed on the southern elevation, and the replacement of the original porch supports with wrought iron. It is in good condition.
