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Description

The one-story, one-room Russell jail is located behind the town's post office and barbershop. Although intact, the structure has been slightly altered, is in fair condition and is somewhat overgrown with brush. It was built with steel rod-reinforced cast concrete and with a concrete roof and foundation. The only alteration has been the removal of the steel door on the front elevation, which is currently replaced with plywood. Two small, barred openings serve as windows on the two side elevations. • 7

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Significance

This jail, one of only three cast concrete, WPA-constructed jails in the county, is located in Russell, a former station on the Iron Mountain line that was named for a member of the railroad's section crew. The jail's significance lies in its associations with Russell's government in the period following its circa 1935 construction, and also with its connection to the economy and way of life during the Depression era, as symbolized by all of the WPA buildings in the county that meet requirements for registration. [See the associated property type for Religious and Institutional Buildings, Depression Era; and Historic Contexts 2 and 3: Railroad Era and Boom and Bust: The War and Depression Years]. It is being considered for nomination under National Register Criterion A with local significance.

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Verbal Boundary Description:

Beginning at a point located approximately 25 feet to the east of the eastern corner of the jail (located 150 feet northwest of State Highway 367 and 100 feet southwest of County Road 70), proceed northwesterly for a distance of approximately 75 feet along a line running parallel to the northeastern elevation; then proceed southwesterly for a distance of approximately 75 feet on a line running parallel to the northwestern elevation; thence proceed southwesterly for a distance of approximately 75 feet on a line running parallel to the southwestern elevation; thence proceed southwesterly for a distance of approximately 75 feet on a line running parallel to the southwestern elevation; thence proceed northeasterly for a distance of approximately 75 feet on a line running parallel to the southwestern elevation to the point of beginning.

Boundary Justification:

The original lot has been subdivided during the non-historic period, resulting in an indefinite current lot boundary; therefore, this boundary includes all the property historically associated with this resource that retains its integrity.
