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Description

The Weber House is a single story, wood frame Craftsman residence. Its continuous gable roof shelters its rectangular, front gable plan. A flue rises from the western slope of the roof toward the northern elevation. The roof material is composition shingle, the walls are sheathed in novelty siding, and the foundation is composed of brick piers.

The southern or front elevation features a recessed porch beneath a dominating, broad gable end roof. The pediment is sheathed in novelty siding and decorated with knee brackets. The two central entrances below reveal the double pen floor plan and each door is flanked by an outside three-over-one wood sash window. The eastern and western elevations are decorated at the corners with the exposed rafters and fenestrated with the same kind of windows placed in identical locations. The hipped roof rear ell is recent and of concrete block construction.

The Weber House is intact and unaltered; it is in good condition.

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Significance

Criterion C, local significance

The Weber House (Part E, Historic Context #4) is the best example in Russell of a single story, wood frame, front gable Craftsman style residence. Constructed in 1933, this house is typical of the third period in the evolution of Craftsman style designs in White County. Its floor plan has become very regular and symmetrical and features only the vestiges of the irregularity of plan and elevation which was one of the hallmark features of this building style.

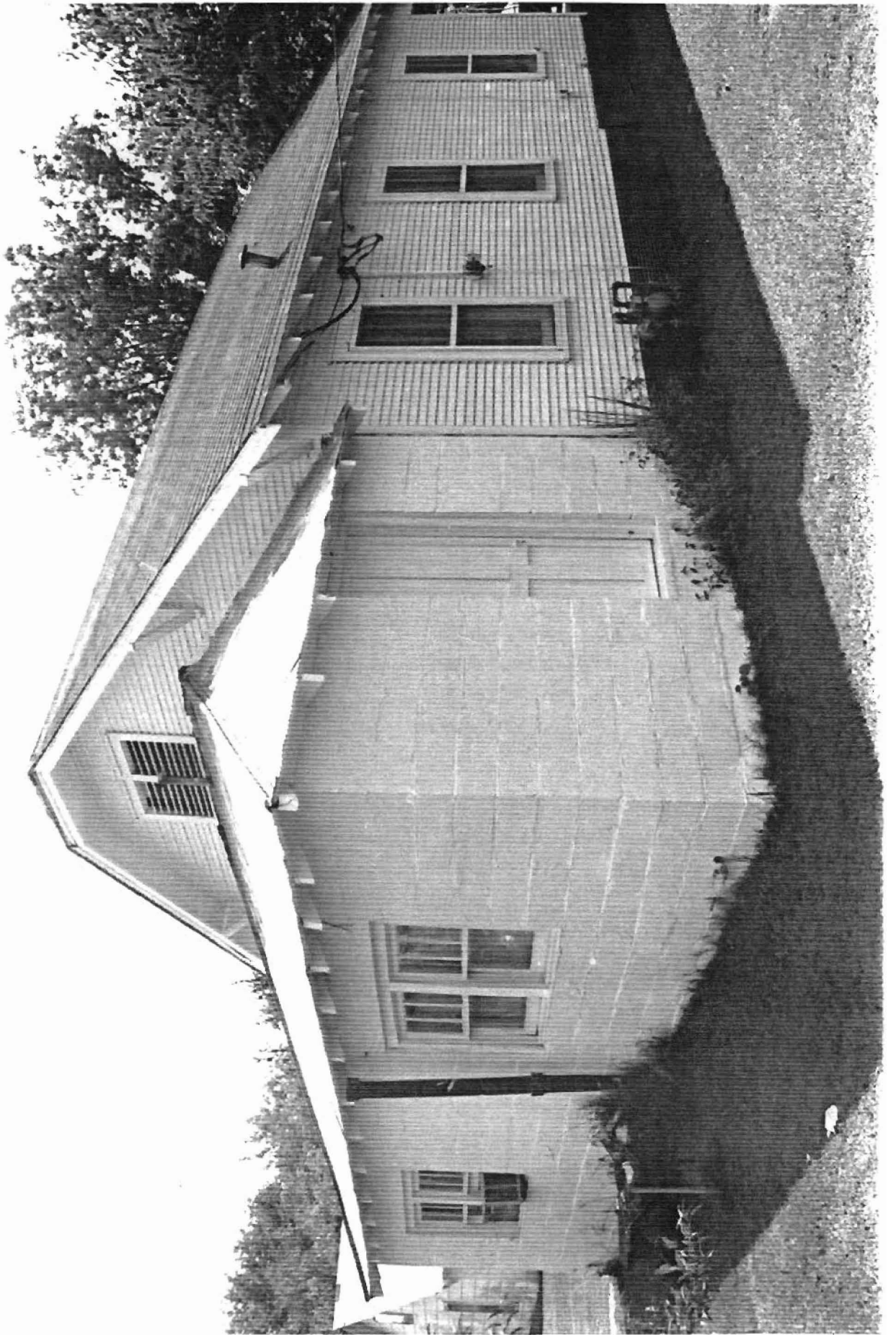

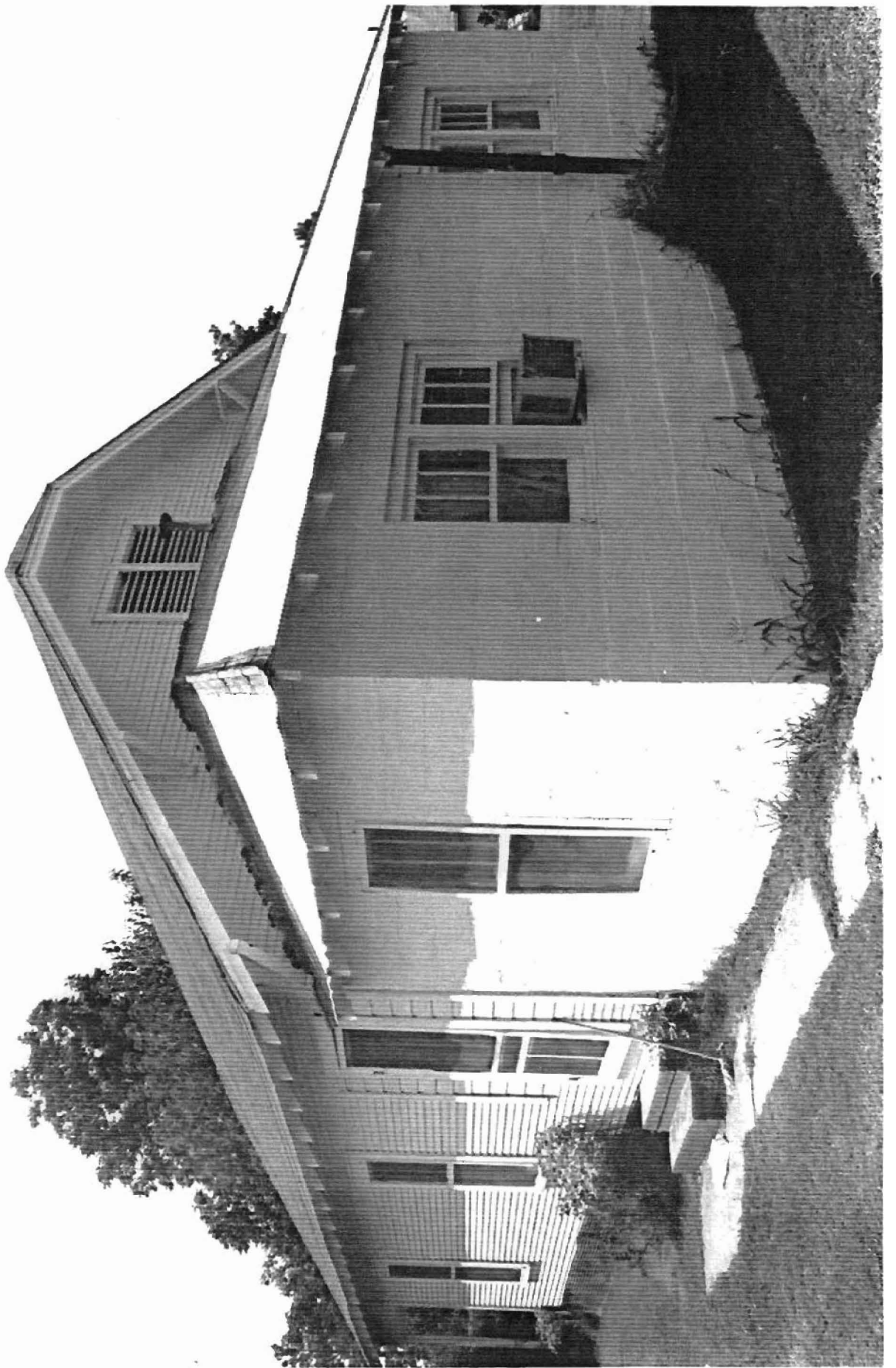
